



## U-IMPACT: UMU INCOMING MOBILITY PROGRAMME ACTION

### RESOLUTION FOR CONTRACTING EXPERIENCED INCOMING RESEARCHERS WITHIN THE MARIE CURIE ACTION COFUND (7<sup>TH</sup> FRAMEWORK PROGRAMME OF THE EU). BEN ARABI PROGRAMME, ISAAC PERAL ACTION FOR 2011

Based on Resolution R-245/2011, May 23rd 2011 of the Rector of the University of Murcia, for contracting five (5) Experienced Researchers, taking into account the Pre-emptive Resolution Proposal of the Selection and Resolution Proposal Commission of the U-IMPACT Programme, and the "Call Bases" of the above-mentioned Resolution, agree:

First: to offer an **UMU Incoming Mobility Programme ACTION (U-IMPACT)** contract to the candidates listed in Annex I of this Resolution

Second: to create a list of alternate candidates (Annex II) as established in Section VI and VII of the Resolution R-245/2011

Third: Appeals can be made against this resolution, which finalizes the administrative processes before the same organism which has awarded them, via internal appeal, in a period of one month starting from the following day of its publication, in accordance with the provisions of Article. 116 of Spanish Law Legal Framework of the Public Authorities and Common Administrative Procedure, November 26<sup>th</sup>, 1992.

If an internal appeal is not made, an administrative appeal can be made within the space of two months from the notification of the agreement, as set out in Spanish law 29/1998, July 13<sup>th</sup> regulatory law of said jurisdiction. (Paragraph 8 of the Resolution R-245/2011)
