

Dear friends and collaborators of Women for Africa Foundation,

We are pleased to announce that, for another year, our Foundation has launched a **LEARN AFRICA 2024** call, the postgraduate scholarship program par excellence for African women students.

With more than 10 years of experience, LEARN AFRICA leave behind a trail of **350 women students from 35 different countries**, many of whom have successfully finished their studies in Spain or Morocco and either have achieved access into the labour market of their respective countries or have decided to continue with doctoral studies.

In this new call for applications, the Women for Africa Foundation made a **solid bet for doctoral scholarships** —the year with the most doctorate scholarships offered— apart from maintaining a continuous and promoting line of academic programme in **STEM fields** (science, technology, engineering and mathematics). In this context, **innovative themes** such as artificial intelligence, biotechnology, food safety and sustainable building have been included in, among others.

Altogether, in this new edition, **76 new scholarships and 22 follow-on scholarships** has been offered thanks to the immutable engagement of the more than 50 collaborators of the programme, including universities, educational centres and private funders, such as GMV, the ASISA Foundation and the ANESVAD Foundation.

Doubtlessly, the success that the programme has achieved is not only reflected in the number and diversity of scholarships offered or the impact that the LEARN AFRICA experience has on its beneficiaries' lives, but also the wide ensemble of collaborators who participate in the programme, which does not stop growing each year. Thus, for this call, LEARN AFRICA have the honour of counting on for the first time with the University of Almería (UAL) and the ENAE Business School (Murcia). Both institutions have started their journey in the programme with a strong bet of two scholarships each.

All the information of the call for applications, as well as how to proceed to apply for a scholarship, their coverage and the requirement of each academic programme is available on the Foundation's website. **The deadline to apply for a scholarship will be open until the 17th April 2024 at 23:59 (Madrid).**
